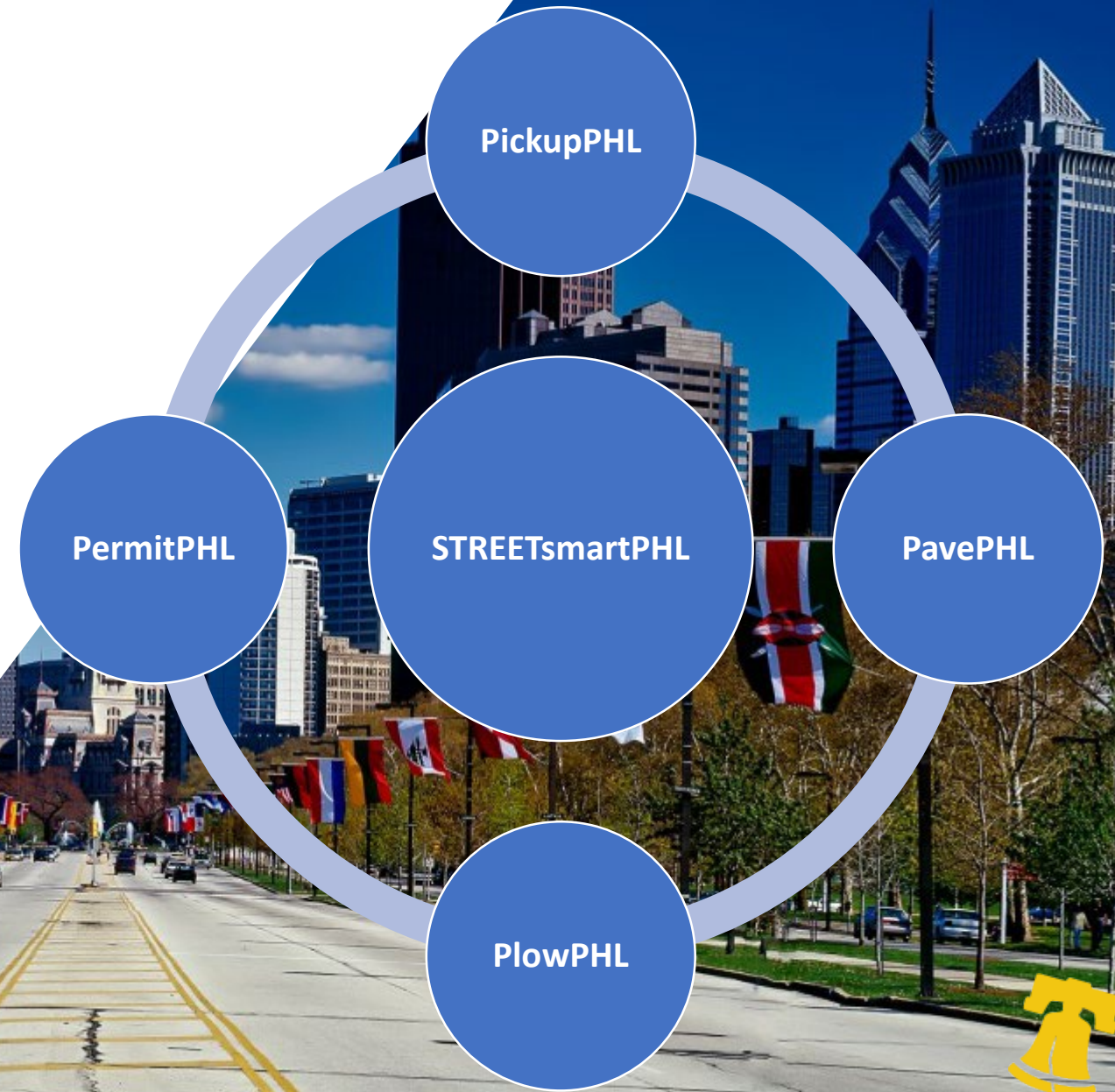

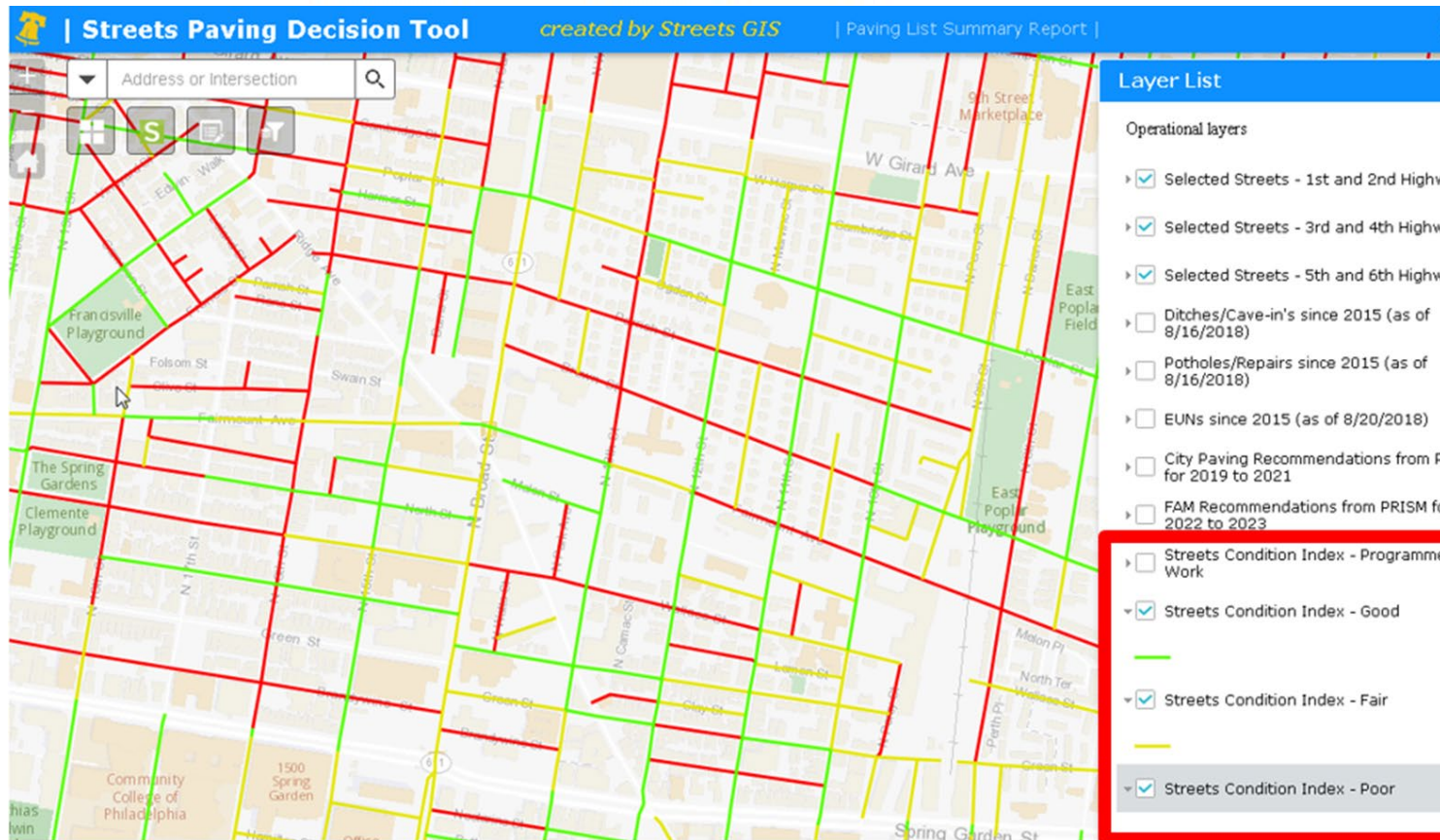

- Interactive paving tool that allows access the Streets Department most up-to-date paving information.

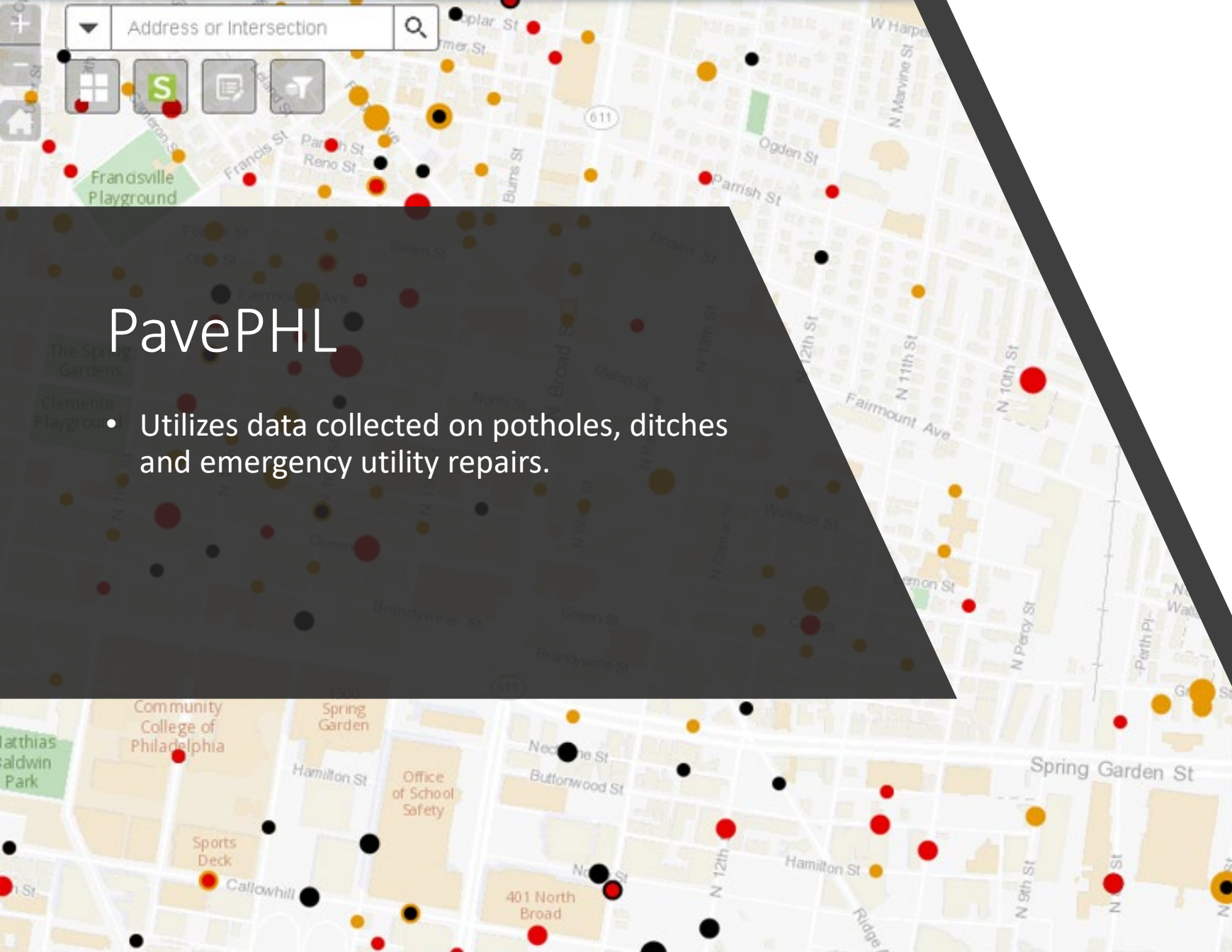




- PavePHL is an online portal that provides access to the Street's Department paving program.

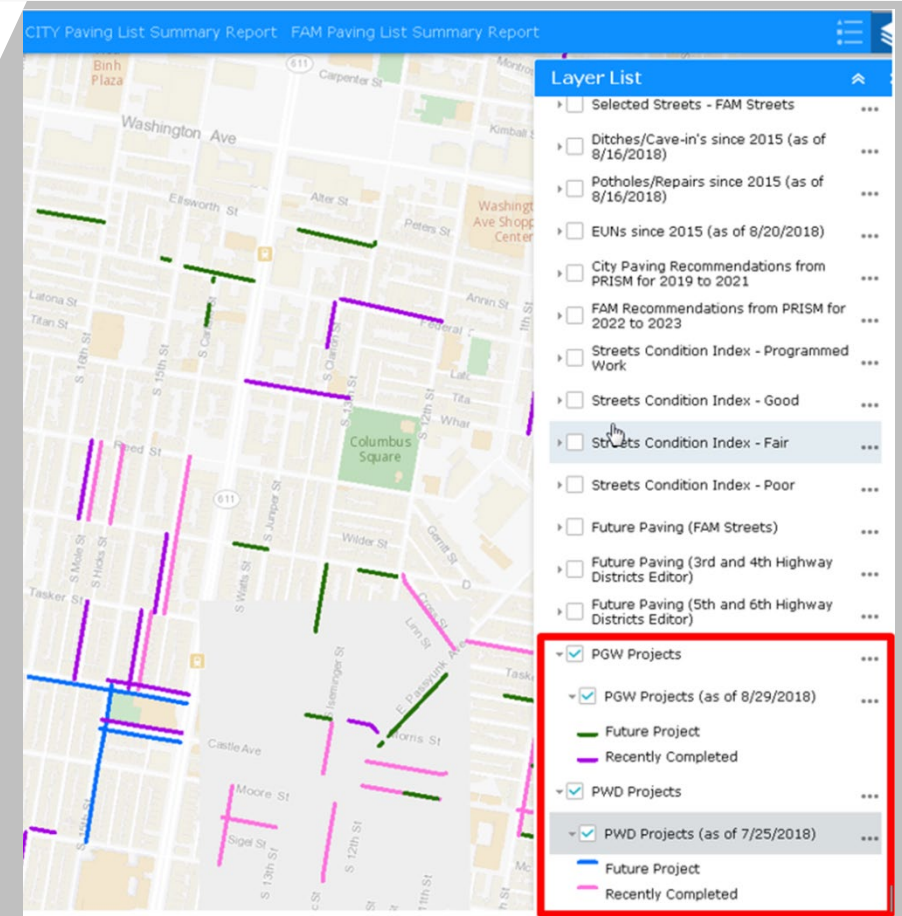

PavePHL

- Provides improved coordination with public and private utility companies for street paving projects.



PermitPHL

- Permit PHL is an interactive mapping tool that provides easy-to-read information pertaining to permits for street closures.
- Provides information regarding street closure permits issued for construction projects, special events, block parties, detours and right of way information.

PermitPHL

- The Right-of-Way unit provides permits for closures related to sidewalks, parking lanes and partial, full or roving streets closures.
- Communication with the general public regarding these and other closures have been limited.



PermitPHL



- Provide streamlined real-time access to information obtained on permit requests for closures on city streets and sidewalks.
- Provide additional opportunities to interface with the public
- Provide an additional direct-line of communication to 311 for user reporting of issues related to street closures including hazardous conditions, closures causing conflicts and non-permitted closures.

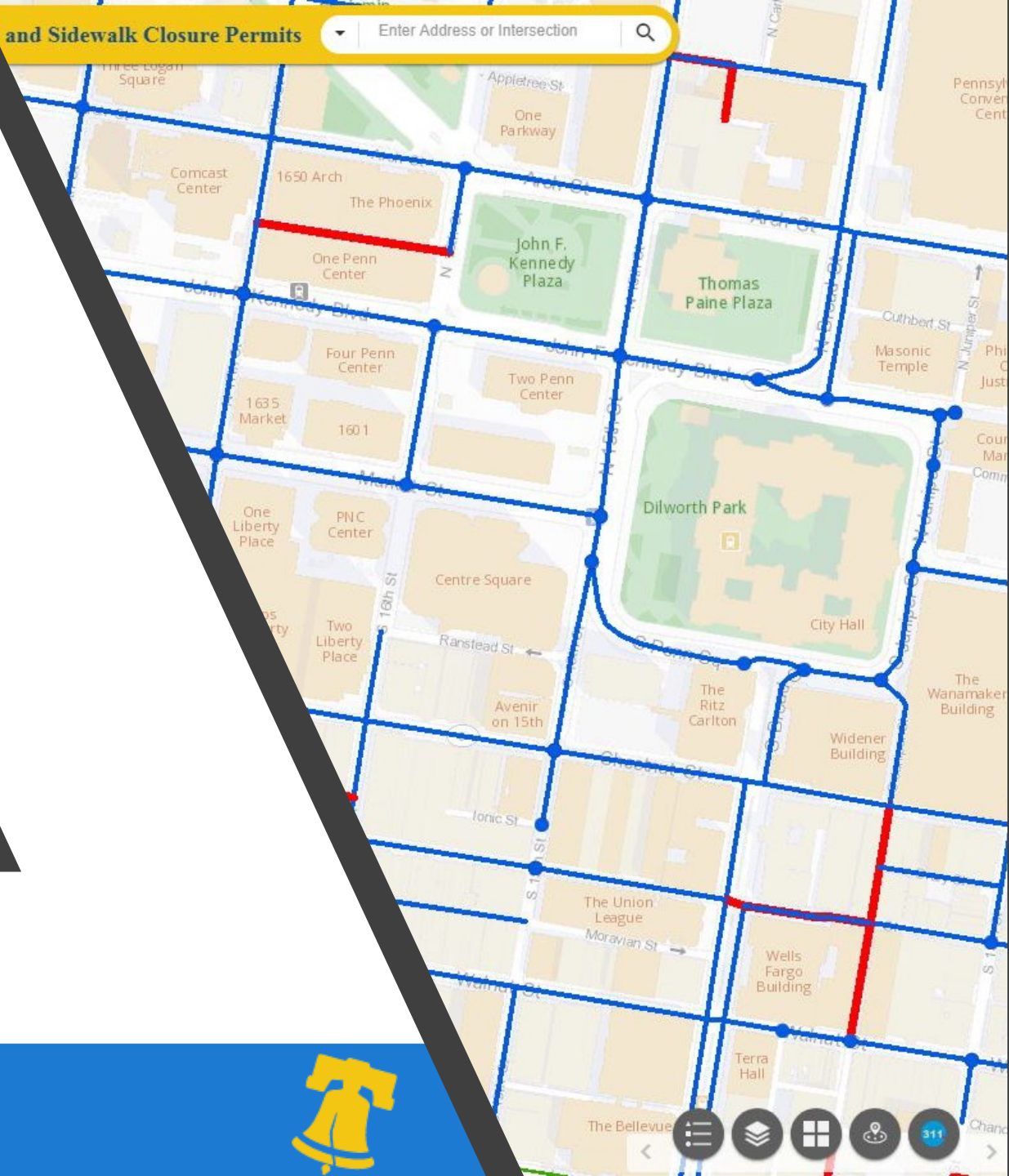


PermitPHL

- Visitors to the interactive web portal housing Permit PHL (stsweb.phila.gov/closephl/) are able to select a location by keying in an address or using the auto-locator function.

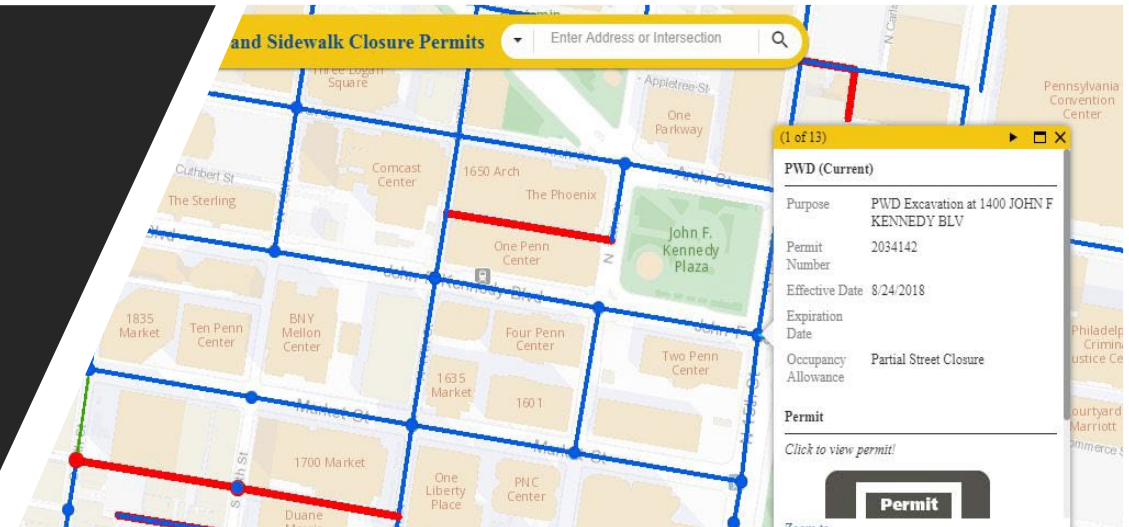
Street and Sidewalk Closure Permits

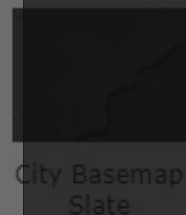

PermitPHL

- Functions of the site include a legend featuring six data points, an option to search permits near me, a layered section covering current and future closures, an opportunity to look at base map photos found in Atlas and the ability to submit a request directly to 311 from the site



PlowPHL

- Check the status of the Streets Department snow removal operations to learn which streets are plowed and passable during a snow event.

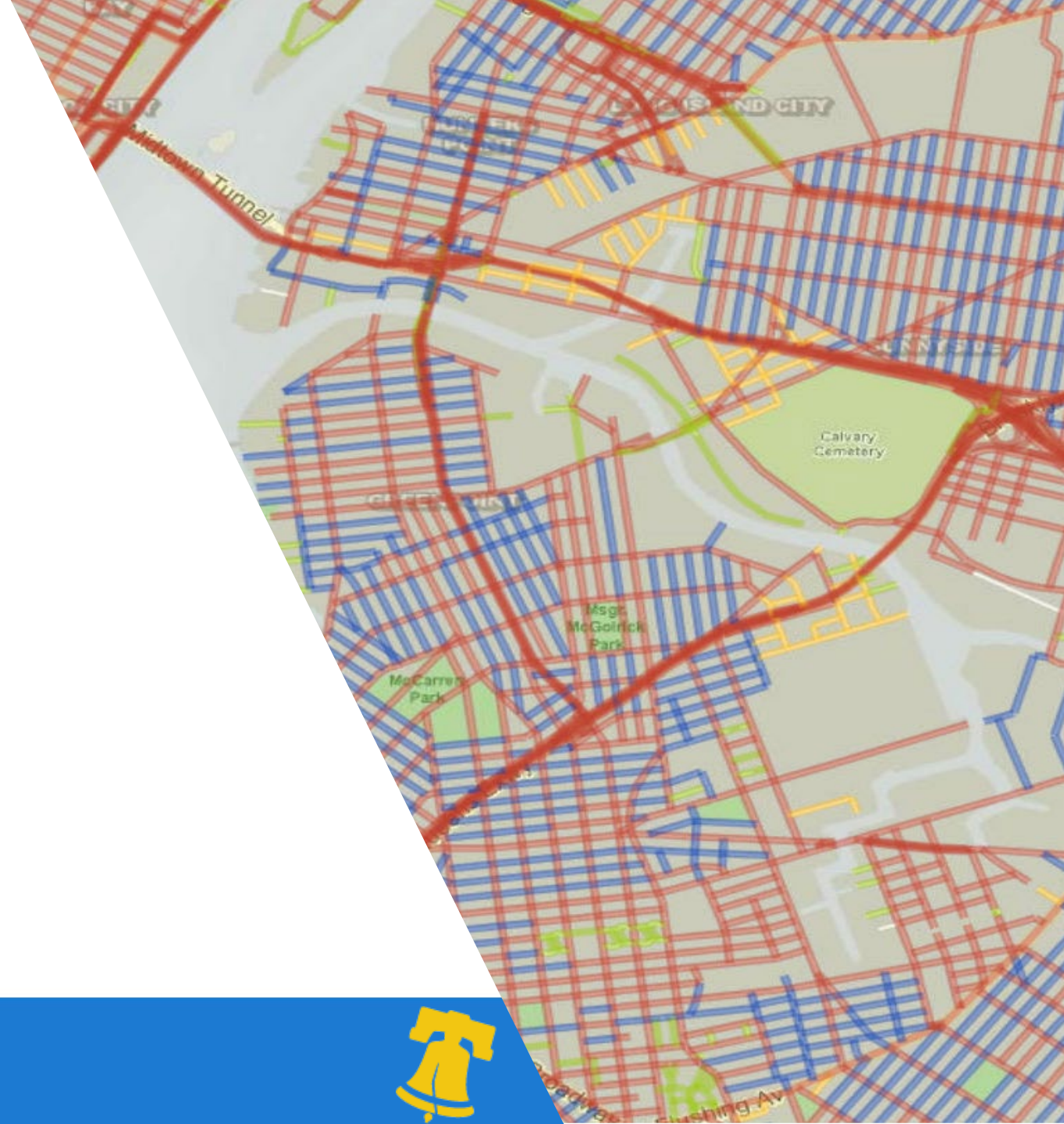
Location of Streets Plowed

Time Streets Plowed



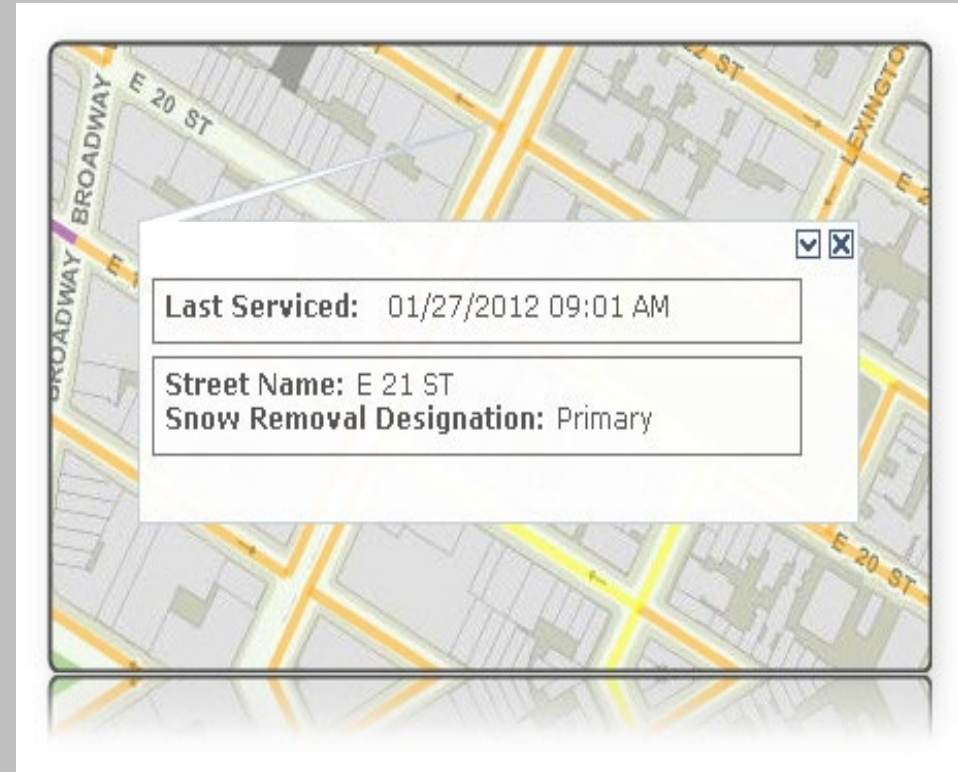
PlowPHL

- PlowPHL is an online map portal for displaying information related to the Department of Streets snow plowing efforts during a snow emergency.
- The application provides access to information regarding recent plow activity at the street level and allows the user to perform searches based on location.



PlowPHL

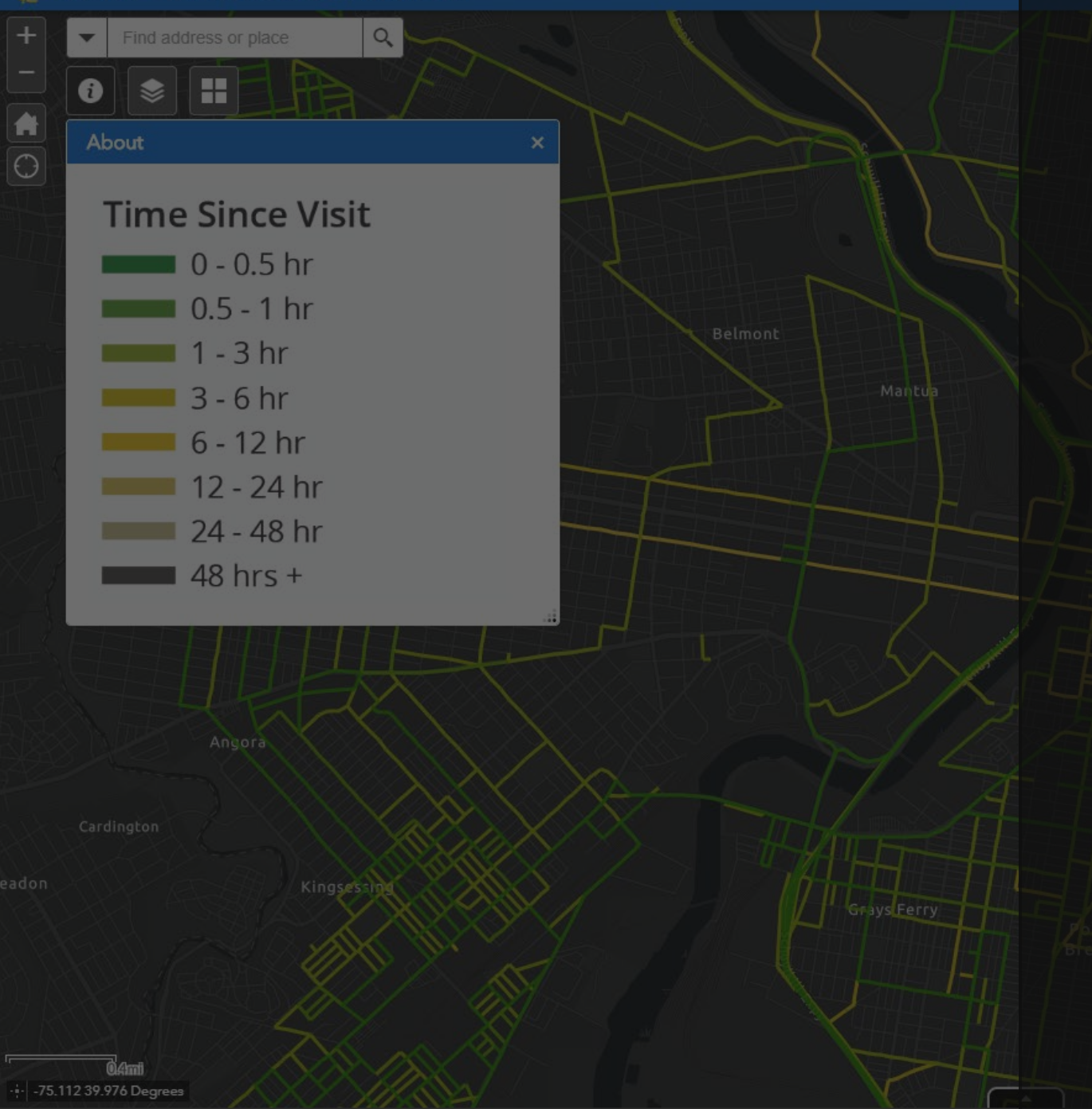
- The pop-up can include last time a street was serviced as well as its snow removal designation.



PickupPHL

- View the Streets Department solid waste collection services to determine the status of daily trash, recycling, bulk, leaf and other collection services.





PickUp PHL

- PickUp PHL allows residents to monitor Sanitation Division compactors in real time to determine if trash and recycling was collected in the neighborhood.

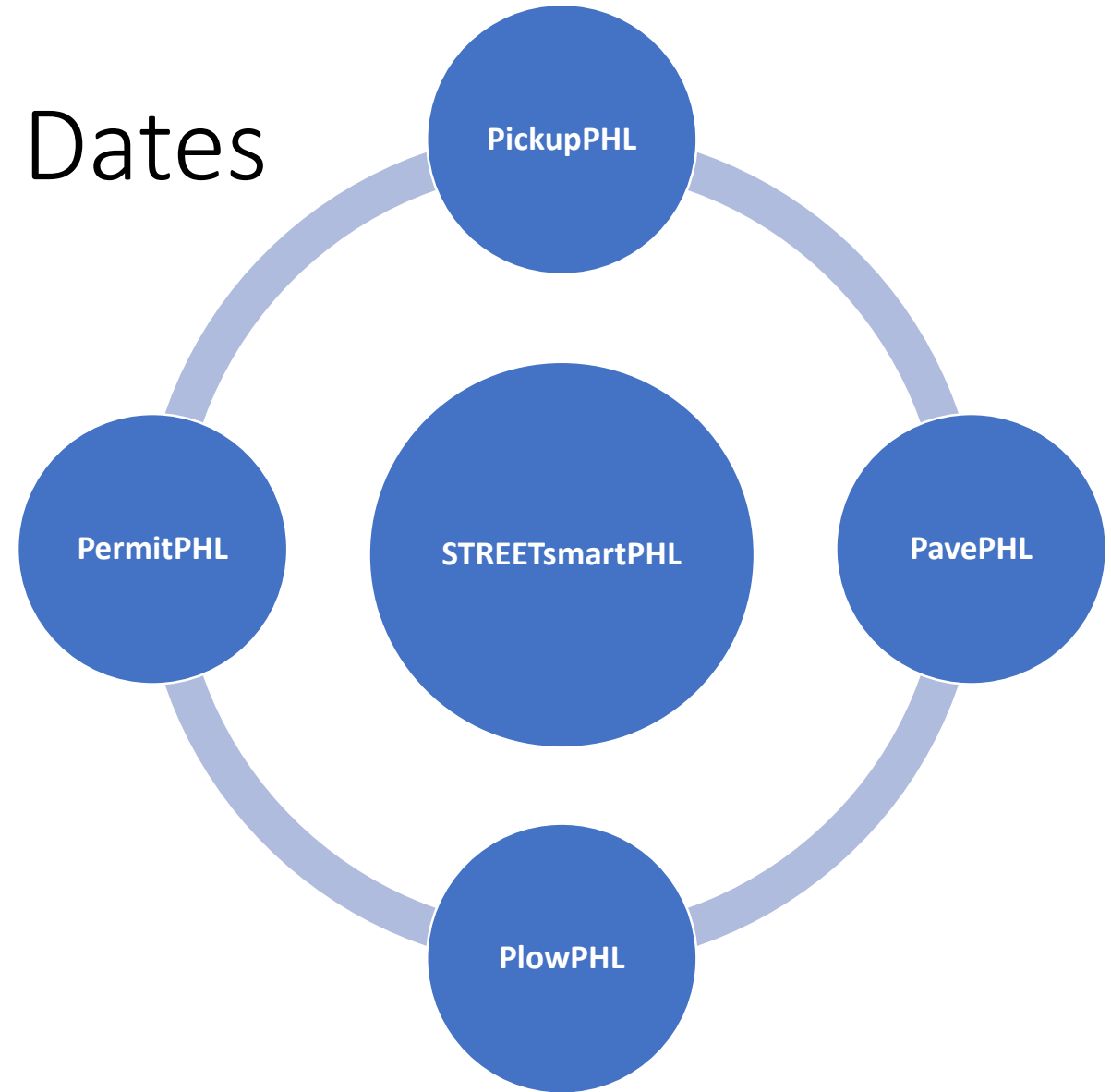
